What does WISEWOMAN provide?


WISEWOMAN covers services that include:

- Screenings for:
 - ♥ Overall cardiovascular risk
 - ♥ Cholesterol
 - **Blood** pressure
 - Diabetes and prediabetes
 - Healthy weight
- Counseling to reduce risk for heart disease and stroke
- Patient referrals to healthy lifestyle programs, other health behavior support options, and low-cost medication resources
- Patients also enrolled in BCCHP qualify for breast and cervical cancer screening services which include:
 - Mammogram
 - Pap test
 - Follow-up diagnostic and treatment after abnormal results

WISEWOMAN is a program created to help people understand and reduce their risk for heart disease and stroke by providing services to promote lasting heart-healthy lifestyles.

This program serves people who:

- ♥ Live in areas where WISEWOMAN services are available
- ◆ Are between the ages of 35–64
- Have a low income
- ♥ Do not have insurance or have high out-of-pocket costs
- ♥ Are eligible for the Breast, Cervical & Colon Health **Program**
